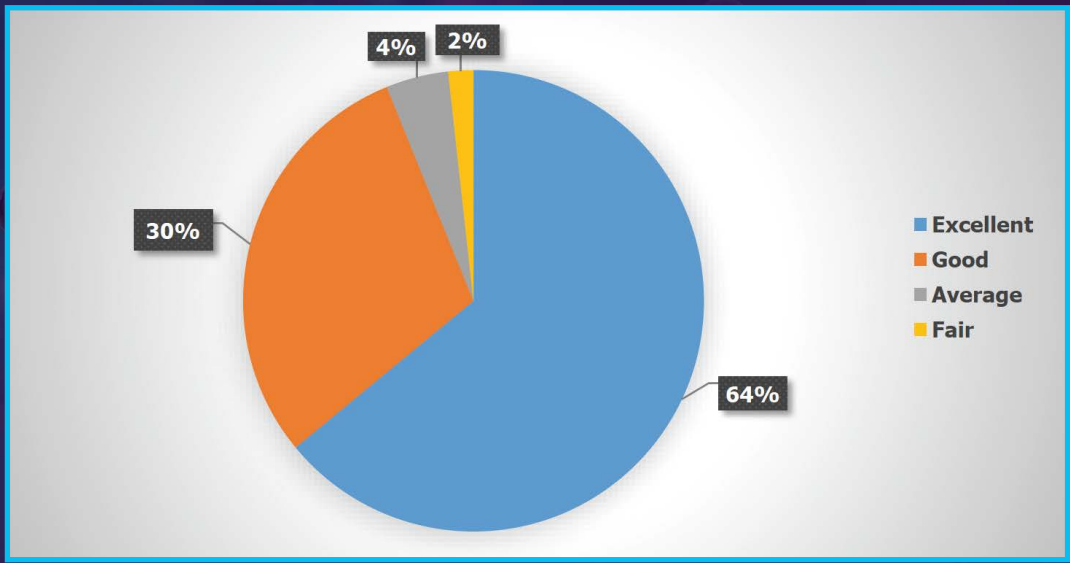


Registration by Countries

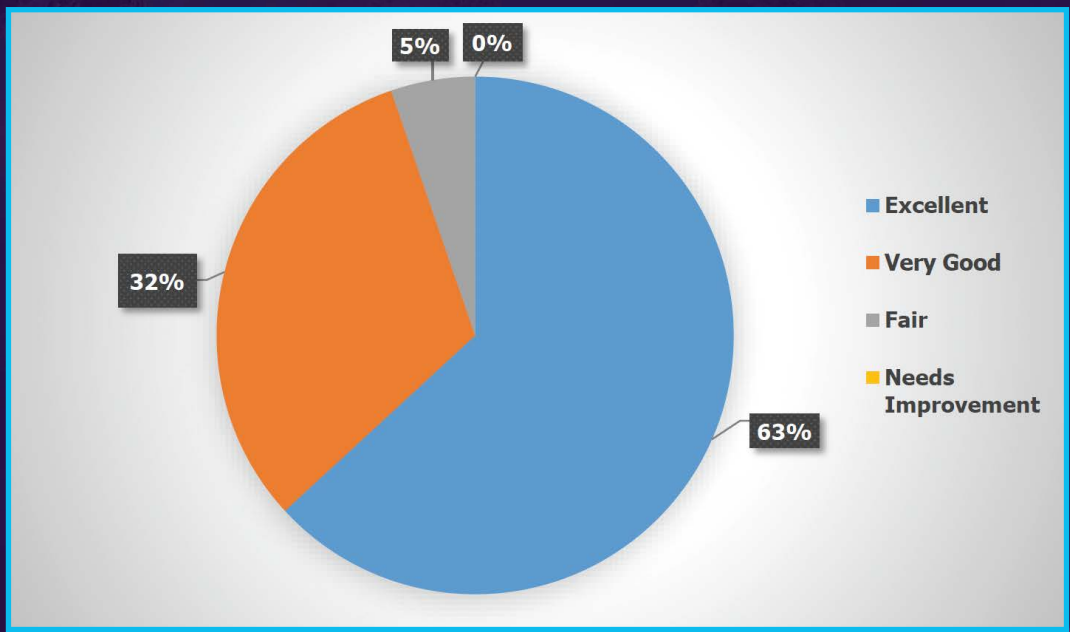




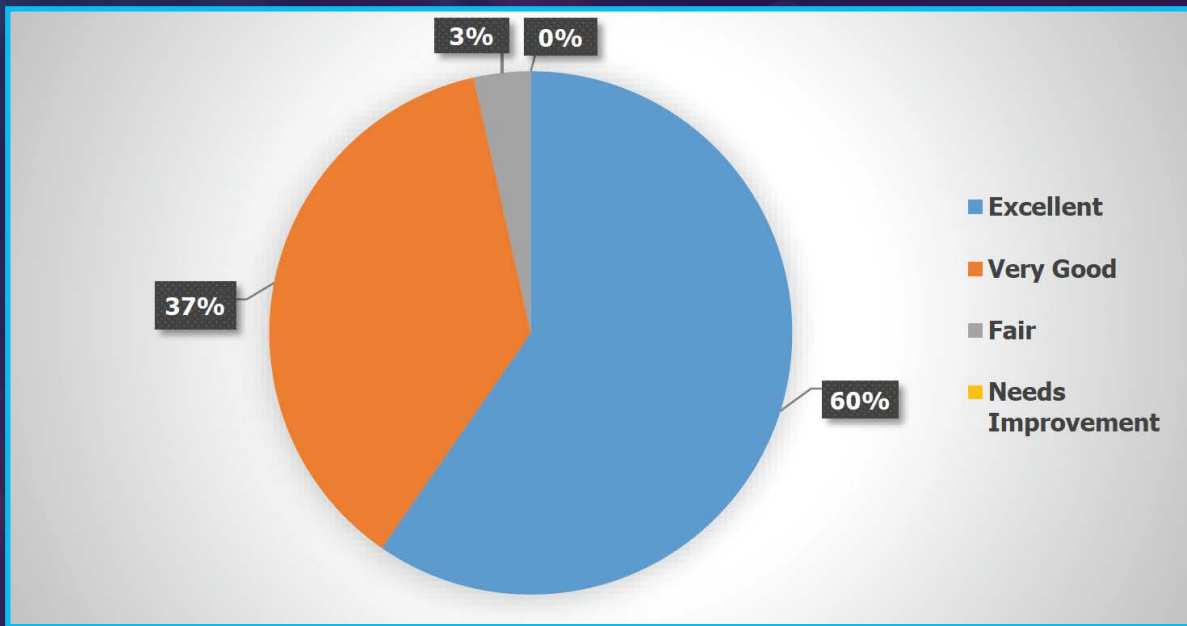

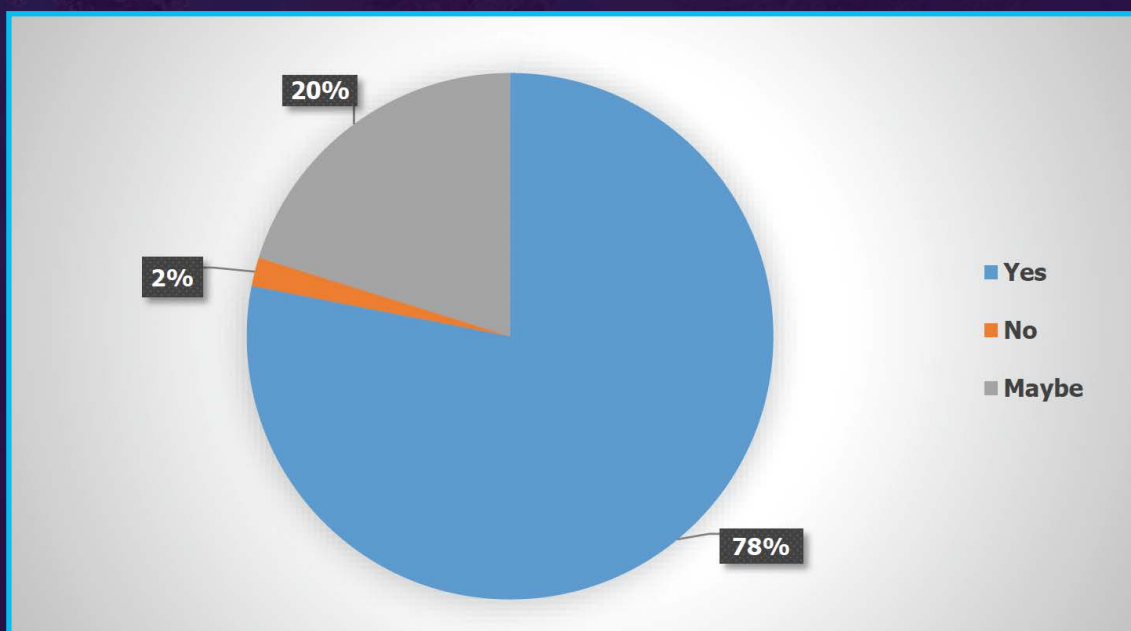

Faculty Dinner – Saturday, 8 November 2025

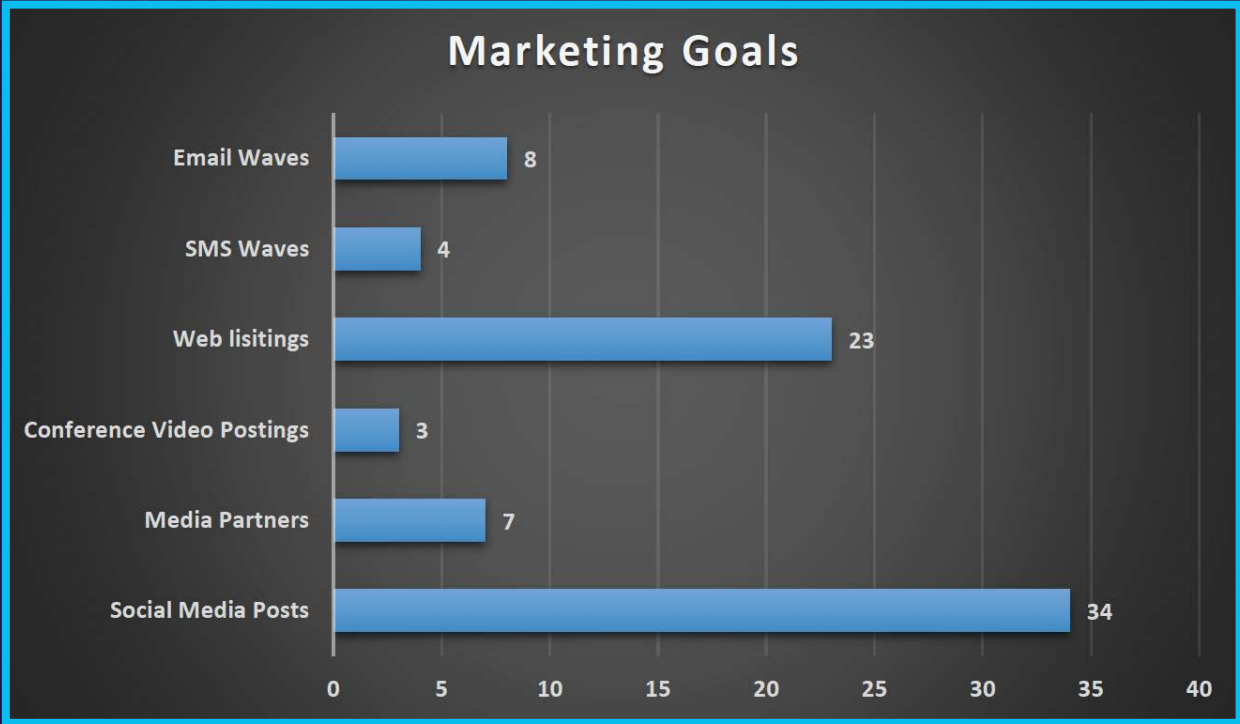
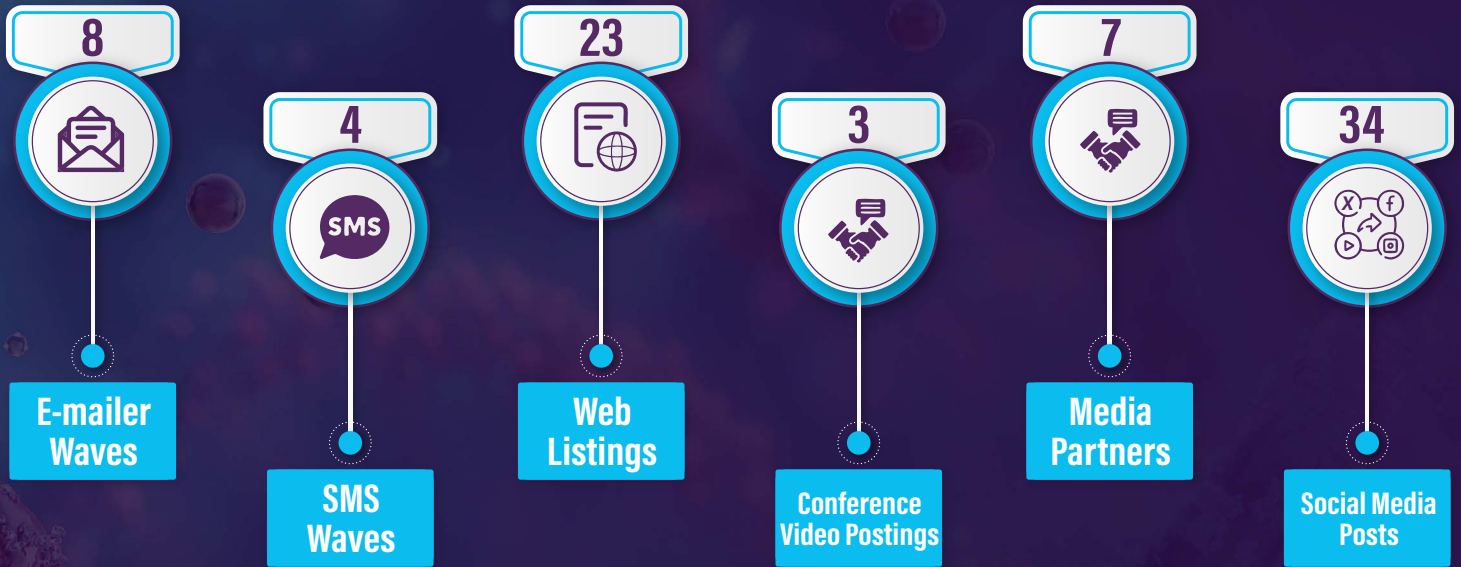

The dinner was hosted by one of our industry partners, Al Fahim Healthcare Solutions.

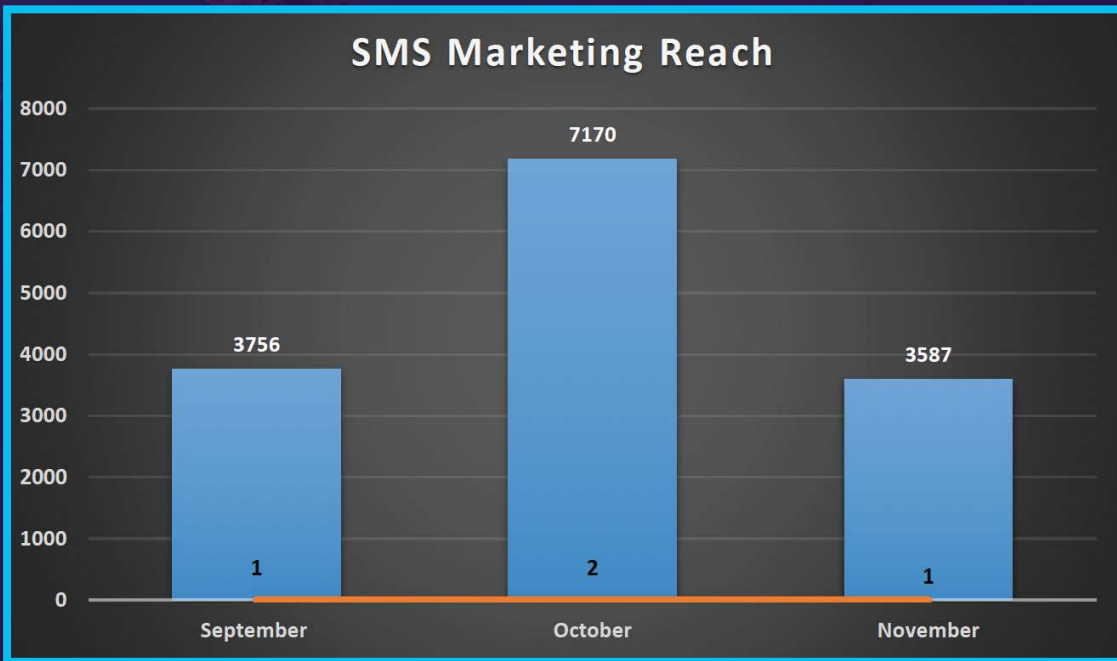
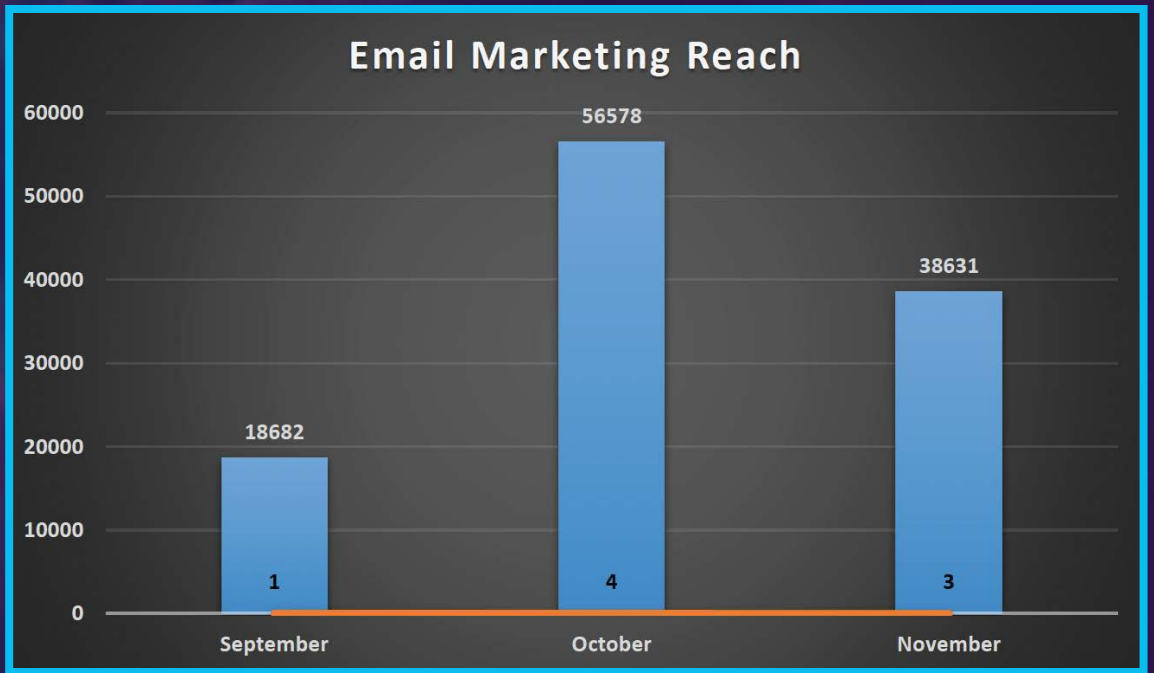
